STATUS REPORT ON DEVELOPMENT, REVIEW, AND ADOPTION OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN FOR 2035

Action Requested: Receive and file

Recommendation

Receive and file an informational report from SACOG staff on development of the Metropolitan Transportation Plan.

Discussion

SACOG's update of the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) is nearing completion. The MTP is the comprehensive strategy for addressing long-term transportation needs in the six-county Sacramento region. This update will have a planning horizon of 2035. It is the first MTP based on the *Regional Blueprint* of land development, which is designed to allow more people to choose non-automobile travel options for routine daily trips. The draft MTP and environmental impact report are currently being circulated for public review. It is anticipated that the SACOG Board will adopt a final MTP for 2035 in February or March.

At today's meeting, SACOG staff will present an overview of the MTP from a Sacramento County perspective, and will describe the significance of the Measure A transportation sales tax program to the Plan's funding assumptions and project list.
