**INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATION ON NEW MEASURE A CAPITAL PROJECT:
SACRAMENTO INTERMODAL TRANSPORTATION FACILITY**

Recommendation

Receive and file an informational presentation on the Sacramento Intermodal Transportation Facility.

Discussion

Today, we begin an occasional series of informational presentations on **New** Measure A capital projects. City of Sacramento Transportation Dept. staff will provide an overview of the proposed Sacramento Intermodal Transportation Facility. This project, which will take shape outside the STA's administrative office, involves upgrading and perhaps relocating the existing Amtrak station into a modern facility where travelers will conveniently transition among Amtrak, light rail, local bus, intercity bus, and taxi services. It is a critical element of the City's plan to develop the former UP Railyards property into a lively mixed-use extension of Downtown.

The Intermodal facility is estimated to cost about \$335 million, of which \$110 million will come from **New** Measure A revenues.
