**INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATION ON NEW MEASURE A CAPITAL PROJECT:
HAZEL AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS (PHASE I)**

Action Requested: Receive and file

Recommendation

Receive and file an informational presentation on the County of Sacramento's effort to widen Hazel Avenue and to add improvements to facilitate non-motorized travel options.

Discussion

Today, we continue an occasional series of informational presentations on **New** Measure A capital projects. County Department of Transportation staff will provide an overview of current design and construction activities on Hazel Avenue. Phase I improvements are currently underway. The project will ultimately result in enhanced vehicle capacity and improved access for cyclists, pedestrians, and people with disabilities between Folsom Boulevard and the Placer County line. Hazel Avenue is a primary north-south travel corridor in the eastern portion of the County.

Over \$61 million is earmarked for this project (Phase I & II) in the **New** Measure A capital improvement plan. The total project cost is estimated to be \$184 million. The County also has plans to extend these improvements southward to Folsom Boulevard at a later date.
