

What is FSP?

The FSP Program is a congestion management program operating on major freeways in Sacramento and Yolo counties that facilitates the rapid clearing of crashes and other incidents, thereby improving traffic flow.

FSP tow truck drivers patrol designated sections of congested freeways primarily during peak traffic periods, stopping to assist motorists, removing debris from the roadway or towing vehicles from the freeways.

What Services are Offered?

If your automobile stops running while on the freeway, the Freeway Service Patrol can assist you by:



- Providing a gallon of fuel
- Changing a flat tire
- Jump starting your vehicle
- Making minor repairs
- Free tow to a CHP-identified location if your vehicle can't be fixed in 10 minutes
